Per The International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) The Department of State is responsible for the export and temporary import of defense articles and services governed by 22 U.S.C. 2778 of the Arms Export Control Act (AECA) and Executive Order 13637. Whether you use our in-house design services, or are just looking to complete a production run, we can ensure the privacy and security of your designs and products throughout our plant. Caltronics' ITAR procedures are governed by our ITAR Manual (SP-0009).

We know that securing a government contract is no small feat, so it is especially crucial to know that those working on your product are U.S. People, and that your intellectual property is secured against data breaches. In addition to the internal transferring and storage of files, upon confirmation that your project is ITAR, Caltronics employs various techniques to safeguard your product from outside sources too.

From material sourcing to manufacturing processes, every aspect is carefully managed to prioritize the security and quality of your product. Upon request Caltronics will provide a product-specific Certificate of Conformance (CofC) to you for your records.
